## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to condominium or homeowners associations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Section 22 of
- 2 Chapter 183A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after the first paragraph the following paragraph:-
- 4 "Any person who is a member of a condominium or homeowners association and who
- 5 violates any provision of this chapter or other governing documents, including the by-laws of the
- 6 organization of unit owners, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or removal from
- 7 the board of trustees of said organization of unit owners".
