## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to bicycle safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Section 11B of chapter 85 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended in the second paragraph, clause (iii) by striking out, in line 36:- "16 years of

3 age or younger" and further amended by adding at the end thereof, the following new

4 paragraph:-

The Department of Public Health, or other appropriate state agency, shall pursue means
by which to encourage bicycle operators to wear highly-visible waist-up clothing while
bicycling. Such clothing should be fluorescent with reflective areas for visibility both during
daylight and darkness, as consistent with the American National Standards Institute 107-1999
Class II conspicuity standard.
