### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act Relative to Child Welfare.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Paragraph 8 of Section 13J of Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended to strike out the words "shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than two and
- 3 one-half years in the house of correction." And insert "shall be punished by imprisonment in the
- 4 state prison for not more than ten years or by imprisonment in the house of correction for not
- 5 more than two and one-half years or by a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars or by both
- 6 such fine and imprisonment."
- 7 SECTION 2: Paragraph 9 of Section 13J of Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby
- 8 amended to strike out the words "shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than two and
- 9 one-half years in the house of correction." And insert "shall be punished by imprisonment in the
- 10 state prison for not more than ten years or by imprisonment in the house of correction for not
- 11 more than two and one-half years or by a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars or by both
- 12 such fine and imprisonment."
