Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 3 in place thereof the following:-
- 4 No person under the age of 18 shall handle any alcohol or alcohol container, opened, unopened,
- 5 for any purpose including stocking, bagging and accepting and returning recyclable materials.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 64 of said chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby amended in the first
- 7 paragraph, by inserting after the first sentence, the following sentence:-

- 8 In the instance that the licensee's retail sale location is attached to or a part of another
- 9 commercial activity at that location, the above remedies shall be applied to those premises also.
