AN ACT RELATIVE TO INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO FOSTER CHILDREN BY THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 51B of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by adding the following paragraph:—

3 Any employee of the department shall be liable for criminal prosecution for child endangerment by the act of
4 screening out any report for abuse or neglect received under section 51A brought against a foster home or residential
5 placement where the department has placed a child without referral to law enforcement.

6 Such employee may also face administrative sanctions in the form of suspension, termination or revocation of
7 license.
