*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the executive office of health and human
- 2 services shall make all reasonable efforts to renegotiate the commonwealth’s 1115 waiver to
- 3 permit passive opt-out enrollment for the senior care options plan.
