An Act to reduce underage drinking.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 34 the following
- 2 section:-
- 3 Section 34A ³/₄
- 4 A licensee licensed under this chapter except Section 29 shall be required to place a warning
- 5 label on single and multi-pack containers of beer and single and multi-pack containers of wine to
- 6 include the following:

7 WARNING: A person who provides alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of age, if
8 convicted under section 34 could be imprisoned for up to 1 year and fined up to \$2,000 or both
9 such imprisonment and fine.
