An Act relative to hoisting license renewal.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 53 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 37, of subsection (c) by inserting after the word  
3 “section.” the following:-

4           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the commissioner of public  
5 safety shall not promulgate any rules or regulations requiring more than two hours of classroom  
6 credit every four years for renewal of a hoisting license.
