An Act relative to clarifying procedures for the custodial protection of a child requiring assistance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 39H of Chapter 119 of the General Laws, as most recently 2 amended by chapter 240 of the acts of 2012, is hereby amended by inserting in the first line of 3 clause (ii) after the word "and" the word:- preferably.

4 SECTION 2. Section 39H of Chapter 119 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 5 2010 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by striking the sentence "A child in custodial 6 protection may not be confined in shackles or similar restraints or in a court lockup facility in 7 connection with any proceedings under sections 39E to 39I inclusive." and inserting in place 8 thereof :- The preferred response by law enforcement and court officials when a child is in 9 custodial protection in connection with any proceedings under sections 39E to 39I inclusive is to 10 avoid the use of shackles and court lockup facilities when practicable.
