## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to manufactured housing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of Section 32L of Chapter 140 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended in lines 6 and 8 by striking out the
- 3 words "or change in rent".
- 4 SECTION 2. Subsection (2) of Section 32L of said Chapter 140 is hereby further
- 5 amended by inserting the following words after the existing text:- "Any change in rent that does
- 6 not apply uniformly to all manufactured home tenants of a similar class shall create a rebuttable
- 7 presumption that such change in rent is unfair. With respect to any change in rent, differences in
- 8 the year of entry into an occupancy agreement or tenancy shall render otherwise similar classes
- 9 dissimilar under this subsection. Subsection (2) shall apply retroactively."
