The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to veterans' grave markers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 73A the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 73B. (a) Whoever sells or attempts to sell a veteran's grave marker, other than a
- 4 person authorized by law to sell such a marker, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
- 5 \$5,000.
- 6 (b) Whoever receives, retains or disposes of a veteran's grave marker or other structure or
- 7 thing designed to commemorate the grave of a veteran, which the person knows or should know
- 8 to be stolen, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$5,000; provided, however, that no
- 9 such penalty shall be imposed upon a person who receives or retains such veteran's grave marker
- 10 or other structure or thing with the intent to return it to a cemetery, a member of law
- 11 enforcement, a member of the department of veterans services or a non-profit veterans' services

- 12 group, or a veteran's agent of a town, or upon a person who in fact disposes of such veteran's
- 13 grave marker or other structure or thing in a like manner.
- (c) upon the second or more offenses, whoever sells or attempts to sell a veteran's grave
- 15 marker, other than a person authorized by law to sell such a marker, shall be punished by
- 16 imprisonment in the state prison for not more than five years or by imprisonment in the jail or
- 17 house of correction for not more than two and one-half years and by a fine of not more than five
- 18 thousand dollars.
