## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

## In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to subsequent convictions for assault and battery on a police officer.
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following language:- A
3 second and subsequent conviction under this section shall be punished by imprisonment for not
4 less than 120 days nor more than $2 \frac{1}{2}$ years in a house of correction or by a fine of not less than
