Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 72B of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010

  Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 4 and 5, the words "such punishment as provided by law for the offense" and inserting place thereof the following:- a term of life
- 6 imprisonment without parole, or a term of imprisonment, the minimum of which shall be at least
- 7 25 years to life. Should the person found guilty become eligible for parole, said person shall be
- 8 subject to the provisions of law governing the granting of parole permits by the parole board.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of chapter 265 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2010
- 10 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking the word "Murder" the first time it appears and
- 11 inserting in place thereof, the following: Except as provided under section 72B of chapter 119,
- 12 murder".
- SECTION 3. Section 2 of said chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 14 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 6, the word "Any" and inserting in
- 15 place thereof the following:- Except as provided under section 72B of chapter 119, any".
