## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act amending M.G.L. 32, s. 4(1)(h).

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Paragraph (h) of Subdivision (1) of Section 4 of Chapter 32, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the last paragraph the following paragraph:
- 3 Any retired member who served in the armed forces shall be provided with up to four
- 4 years of creditable service for active service in the armed services of the United States,
- 5 retroactively to the date of retirement.
