An Act amending M.G.L. 32, s. 4(1)(h).

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (h) of Subdivision (1) of Section 4 of Chapter 32, as appearing in the 2014  
2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the last paragraph the following paragraph:

3 Any retired member who served in the armed forces shall be provided with up to four  
4 years of creditable service for active service in the armed services of the United States,  
5 retroactively to the date of retirement.
