In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act creating the crime of larceny by overcoming a security device..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following
- 2 section:
- 3 Section 30B. Any person who, with intent to steal property from any store or other retail
- 4 mercantile establishment, knowingly possesses any item, article, implement or device designed
- 5 for the purpose of overcoming detection of security markings or attachments placed on any
- 6 property offered for sale at such store or establishment shall be punished by imprisonment in jail
- 7 for not more than two years or by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars, or by both such
- 8 fine and imprisonment.
