An Act relative to fees for noncriminal hearings of violations of certain motor vehicle laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The first paragraph of paragraph (4) of subsection (A) of section 3 of  
2 chapter 90C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended  
3 by adding the following sentences:- If the clerk magistrate finds that the accused violator is not  
4 responsible for the citation, the \$25 fee shall be returned by the court to the accused violator. If  
5 the Justice finds that the accused violator is not responsible for the citation, the \$50.00 fee shall  
6 be returned by the court to the accused violator.
