Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1: Section 30, Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out in
- 2 lines 8, 12, 73, and 77 the words “two hundred and fifty dollars” and replacing it with “one
- 3 thousand five hundred dollars”.
