**AN ACT RELATIVE TO CRIMINAL OFFENDER RECORDS OF MINORS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 172I the following
- 2 section:—Section 172J. Notwithstanding section 172, section 60 or 60A of chapter 119 or any other general or
- 3 special law to the contrary, primarily engaged in providing services to children 18 years or less to adults 60 years
- 4 of age or older shall obtain the youthful offender and adjudication of delinquency data concerning sex offender, as
- 5 defined in section 178C, of employees 18 years of age or less.
