**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to false 911 calls from or about school facilities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 14B of Chapter 269 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after subsection a, the following:-

3 (a1/2) Whoever willfully and maliciously makes or causes to be made 1 or more silent
4 calls to any PSAP and thereby causes emergency services to be dispatched 1 or more times to a
5 school shall be punished by imprisonment in a house of corrections for not more than 1 year, by
6 a fine of up to \$500, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
