An Act relative to hit and run drivers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 725, the word "knowingly".

3           Section 2. Section 24 of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
4 out, in line 771, the word "knowingly".

5           Section 3. Section 24 of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking  
6 out, in line 781, the word "knowingly".
