# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to sex offender classification.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 178K of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 51, the words "whether the sex

3 offender has a mental abnormality" and inserting in place thereof the following words:-

4 whether the sex offender has been diagnosed as a pedophile by a Massachusetts licensed 5 mental health clinician.
