AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ENTICEMENT OF CHILDREN ONLINE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 26C of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended, in line 2, by inserting after the word “invite” the following words:-- by any means,  
3 including but not limited to: personal contact, postal mail, telephone, instant electronic messaging and  
4 electronic mail.
