### AN ACT RELATIVE TO CORI REFORM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 172 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 42, after the word “board” the following words:-  
3 provided that said access shall only include information on cases for which a person pleaded  
4 guilty or nolo contendere or was found or adjudicated guilty or delinquent by a court of  
5 competent jurisdiction, or for which a judge made a finding of sufficient facts to support a  
6 finding of guilty or delinquency. Furthermore, the board shall promulgate standards for reports  
7 generated for agencies and individuals granted access under clause (c) clearly detailing the  
8 charges and verdicts in criminal offender record information.
