## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to subdivision ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 82 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting the following new section:—  
3 Section 21A. Notwithstanding procedures otherwise set forth in this chapter, all ways shown on  
4 a definitive plan, approved, constructed and completed in accordance with the provisions of  
5 section 81U of chapter 41, and for which title is otherwise transferred or conveyed to a city or  
6 town by recordable deed or other similar instrument, shall be considered public ways in said city  
7 or town, without need for any further action, all as if said ways were duly laid out by the  
8 selectmen or road commissioners of a town or city council of a city, and otherwise accepted by  
9 town meeting or city council vote.
