## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to eliminating liability limits for abuse of a minor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 85K of chapter 231 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting a new paragraph at the end as follows:
- 4 "The liability limitations set forth in this section shall not apply to any entity in a civil
- 5 action for sexual abuse of a minor, as that term is defined in section 4C1/2 of chapter 260, or a
- 6 civil action for physical abuse of a minor."
