An Act relative to the retirement rights of the employees of the Departments of Public Health, Mental Health, and Developmental Services..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection 2(g) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “children and employees  
3 of Cushing hospital” in line 256 the following words:-  
4 “; and all employees of the departments of developmental services, mental health and public  
5 health; provided, that no member who attains age 65 while classified in Group 1 may thereafter  
6 be classified in Group 2, irrespective of change in employment.”
