An Act Relative to Alcohol Transportation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1: Section 22 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out the words “twenty gallons of malt beverages, three gallons of any other alcoholic  
3 beverage, or one gallon of alcohol” from the first paragraph and inserting “Thirty Two gallons of  
4 malt beverages, four gallons of any other alcoholic beverage, or two gallons of alcohol” in its  
5 place

6 SECTION 2: Section 22 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
7 striking out the words from paragraph 8 “shall be punished by a fine of not more than two  
8 thousand five hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.” And  
9 inserting “shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand five hundred dollars or by  
10 imprisonment in a house of corrections for not more than three months, or both.
