In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act removing the requirement to provide notice to the department of mental health of a license granted to a guardian to sell real estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 12 of Chapter 202 is hereby amended by deleting in the first sentence the words:-

2 or in the case of a person incapacitated by reason of mental illness.
