An Act relative to juror service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 234A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after subsection (8), the following new  
3   subsection:-  
4           “9. Such person is the sole owner of a business and said person’s juror service would  
5   require said person to close the business”
