*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in paragraph (rr), the word “commercial”.
