## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

#### AN ACT CLARIFYING THE REMOVAL STATUTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 30 of chapter 208 of the General Laws, as appearing in the most recent edition, is hereby
- 2 further amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-

3 The removal shall be ordered only if the Court finds that the removal results in a direct benefit to the child which

- 4 outweighs any detriment to the child, including but not limited to, that resulting from the loss of frequent and regular
- 5 visitation with the non-custodial parent.
