An Act relative to the prevailing wage for affordable housing in the town of Wayland.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, sections 26 to  
2 27H, inclusive, of chapter 149 of the General Laws shall not apply to the town of Wayland for  
3 affordable housing-related projects estimated to cost \$30,000 or less.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
