Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 148B of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking, in line 9, the word "and" and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the word:- 'or.'
