An Act removing barriers to justice in the workplace.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 5 of Chapter 151B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 182, the words “300 days” and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following words: “3 years”.
