An Act relative to certain employees of the Massachusetts Department of Fire Services.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting in line 303, after the word "affairs" the following words:-
- 3 , full time employees of the department of fire services in the executive office of public safety
- 4 and security, provided they have previously been full time members of a fire department of any
- 5 city, town, or fire district, including Devens, the Massachusetts Military Reservation Fire
- 6 Department, not previously classified in group 1.
