AN ACT RELATIVE TO ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON PERSONNEL STANDARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. CHAPTER 211B, SECTION 8 IS HEREBY AMENDED BY STRIKING OUT
2 PARAGRAPH ONE AND INSERTING IN PLACE THEREOF:

3 THERE SHALL BE AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF PERSONNEL STANDARDS, THE
4 MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING: THE CHIEF
5 JUSTICE FOR ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT OR HIS DISIGNEE WHO SHALL
6 SERVE AS CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE, ALSO THE CHIEF JUSTICES OF THE TRIAL COURT
7 DEPARTMENTS, THE COMMISIONER OF PROBATION, THE PRESIDENT OF THE
8 ASSOCIATION OF CLERK/MAGISTRATES AND ASSISTANT CLERKS AND THE PRESIDENT
9 OF THE SUPERIOR COURT CLERKS ASSOCIATION. IN ADDITION, THE PRESIDENT OF EACH
10 OF THE AFORE MENTIONED ASSOCIATIONS SHALL APPOINT, FROM AMONG THEIR
11 RESPECTIVE ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP, A FIRST ASSISTANT CLERK AND AN
12 ASSISTANT CLERK; AND ONE REGITER OF PROBATE ELECTED BY THE REGISTERS OF
13 PROBATE. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF SAID COMMITTEE SHALL NOT EXCEED
14 SIXTEEN.
