AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR TANYA M. DUBOIS, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

Whereas, The deferred operation for this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the trial court, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial court shall
2 establish a sick leave bank for Tanya M. Dubois, an employee of the court. Any employee of the court may
3 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Tanya M. Dubois.
4 Whenever Tanya M. Dubois terminates employment with the court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the
5 balance of the sick leave bank time shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
