An Act relative to supplemental services provided by employee organizations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 150E of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 5 the  
2 following section: -

3 Section 5A. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the laws of the  
4 commonwealth shall not be construed to prohibit an Employee Organization from providing only  
5 to its members legal, economic or job-related services or benefits outside of the collective  
6 bargaining agreement, including, but not limited to, dental and vision insurance products.
