Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 6B of chapter 231 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 5 and 6, the words "at the rate of
- 3 twelve per cent per annum" and inserting in place thereof the following:- calculated at a weekly
- 4 average one-year constant maturity treasury yield, as published by the Board of Governors of the
- 5 Federal Reserve System, for the calendar week preceding date of the judgment.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 6C of said chapter 231 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 7 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 4 and 5, the words "at the rate
- 8 of twelve per cent per annum" and inserting in place thereof the following:- calculated at a
- 9 weekly average one-year constant maturity treasury yield, as published by the Board of
- 10 Governors of the Federal Reserve System, for the calendar week preceding date of the judgment.

- SECTION 3. Said section 6C of said chapter 231 is hereby further amended by striking
- out, in line 8, the words "at the rate of twelve per cent annum" and inserting in place thereof the
- 13 following:- calculated as set forth above.
