Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 27D of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-
- For the purposes of this section, the words "construction" and "constructed" shall include
- 4 offsite fabrication work for a qualified project. In such cases, the wage required under this
- 5 chapter shall be paid for such work.
