## AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FAILURE TO SUBMIT TO A POLICE OFFICER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 25 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking in the last line the words “shall be punished by a fine of one
- 3 hundred dollars” and inserting in place thereof the following:-
- 4           “shall be punished by imprisonment in jail for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than five
- 5 hundred dollars.”
