AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPEALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 20A ½ of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 88, the words “judicial review as provided by” and
3 inserting in place thereof the following words:— review in small claims court subject to.
- 4 SECTION 2. Said section 20A ½ of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
5 striking out, in line 130, the words “judicial review as provided by” and inserting in place thereof the
6 following words:— review in small claims court subject to.
- 7 SECTION 3. Said section 20A ½ of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
8 striking out, in lines 148 and 149, the words “judicial review as provided by” and inserting in place
9 thereof the following words:— review in small claims court subject to.
