An Act relative to apprenticeship programs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 11H of chapter 23 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 12, after the word "instruction" the
- 3 following words:- which shall be monitored by a proctor certified through the division of
- 4 apprentice training.
- 5 SECTION 2. Said section 11H of chapter 23, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 6 by inserting, in line 20, after the word "training" the following words:- which shall be monitored
- 7 by a proctor certified through the division of apprentice training.
- 8 SECTION 3. Said section 11H of chapter 23, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 9 by striking out the definition "apprenticeship program" and inserting in place thereof the
- 10 following definition:-
- "Apprenticeship Program", a program which is registered with the division for
- 12 recruitment, selection, employment, training and qualification of apprentices, prior to bidding on
- 13 public projects and will commit to having apprentices on jobsites by 90 calendar days after start
- 14 of contract.
- SECTION 4. Said section 11H of chapter 23, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 16 by striking out the definition "apprenticeship program sponsor" and inserting in place thereof the
- 17 following definition:-
- 18 "Apprenticeship Program Sponsor", a person, association, committee, organization,
- 19 corporation, partnership, trust or other entity operating an apprentice program prior to bidding on

public projects and will commit to having apprentices on jobsite by 90 calendar days after startof contract.
