## In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to minimum tax billing.
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

7 it is payable, or after the thirtieth day after the date on which the bill for such tax was mailed, if 8 mailed after October first, interest at the rate of fourteen per cent per annum computed from

9 October first, or from the date the bill for such tax was mailed, if mailed after October first, shall
10 be paid on such unpaid tax.
