An Act authorizing the Governor to designate an additional justice of the peace in the towns of Groveland and Rowley.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 39 of chapter 207 of the General Laws regulating the
- 2 number of justices of the peace that may be designated, the governor may designate an additional
- 3 justice of the peace in the towns of Groveland and Rowley to solemnize marriages under the
- 4 provisions of said section 39.
