An Act concerning payments on personal injury protection benefit claims.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The fourth paragraph of section 34M of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following two sentences:-

3           If after the commencement of any such action, but before judgment, the insurer makes  
4 payment of the amount that is due and payable, the court may still assess costs and reasonable  
5 attorney’s fees for the bringing and prosecuting of the action, but only up until the time of such  
6 payment. Interest, running from the commencement of the action shall be assessed on all  
7 amounts adjudged to be due and payable in any such action, at the same rate as interest is  
8 assessed for breach of contract actions in the commonwealth.
