An Act relative to double poles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 34B of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “pole;” in line 5, the following:-
3 provided further, that a city or town may enforce this section by the enactment of a local
4 ordinance or bylaw prohibiting double poles beyond the ninety days authorized by this section,
5 violation of which may be punishable by a fine not to exceed a maximum of one thousand
6 dollars per occurrence.
