An Act relative to regulating oxycodone.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31 of Chapter 94 C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after line 85 the following subsection:- (d)
3 Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound,
4 mixture or preparation that contains any quantity of the following substances including its salts,
5 isomers and salts of isomers whenever the existence of such salts, isomers and salts of isomers is
6 possible within the specific chemical designations, as manufactured to delay absorption into the
7 blood system.
