An Act establishing the George Washington memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Route 159 (Main Street) in the City known as the Town of Agawam from its most
- 2 southerly border with the state of Connecticut running northbound to its intersection with Route
- 3 75 (Suffield Street) and Route 147 (Springfield Street) shall be known as the George Washington
- 4 Memorial Highway.
